ABOUT THE ERIE PHILHARMONIC

The Erie Philharmonic is a per-service orchestra that performs in Erie, PA and the surrounding region. For the 2023-24 season, our rates are:

The Erie Philharmonic performs 10 subscription performances each season—5 symphonic and 5 pops—in addition to a summer series, youth concerts, an annual Messiah production, several other special events, and occasional PBS recordings. Symphonic series have four rehearsals and one performance, while pops series typically have either one or two rehearsals and one or two performances. Some symphonic series rehearsals may occur on Monday, or Wednesday, and all symphonic series will have a Friday and Saturday rehearsal in Erie, PA.

Typically, most musicians are offered 40-50 services over the course of each season. All new musicians must spend their first year with the Philharmonic on probation and will be considered for tenure the following year. Qualified candidates must be eligible to work in the U.S.
